Ashland PD Attempts to Identify Prescription Fraud Suspects



The Ashland Police Department is seeking the public's help in identifying possible prescription fraud suspects.

On Friday, March 25, 2016 between 3:30 p.m. and 3:40 p.m., the male subject pictured above left and center attempted to obtain prescription narcotics using forged prescription scrips from pharmacies located on England Street and South Hill Carter Parkway in Ashland. The subject is believed to have been driving a white, 2000's model Ford Crown Victoria.

On Tuesday, March 29, 2016 at about 5:20 p.m., the female subject pictured above right entered a pharmacy in the 600 block of England Street and attempted to obtain prescription narcotics using forged prescription scrip. The subject is believed to have been driving a silver, 2008 Infinity G37 with Maryland registration 1BN0928.
